



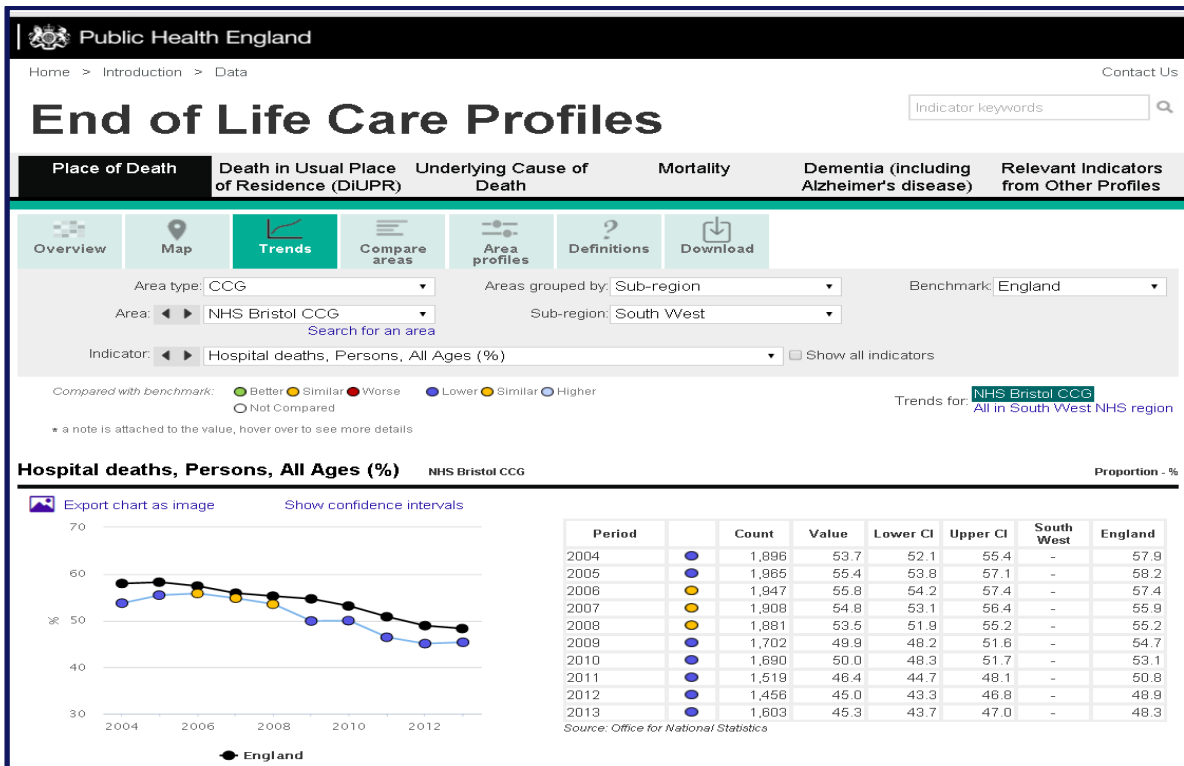

End of life care profiles

These profiles draw together a wide range of information to give an overview of variations in underlying cause and place of death, by age, for each Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG), Strategic Clinical Network (SCN), and Local Authority (LA) in England. They have been produced to improve the availability and accessibility of information around end of life care. The profiles will help commissioners and providers of end of life care services get a clearer picture of the end of life care needs of their local populations. They will help with the planning and delivery of services and

support local decision making on end of life care. Features include:

- over 66 indicators, presented in six different domains
- uses Office for National Statistics mortality data from 2004 – 2013
- breakdown for place and underlying cause of death and death in usual residence
- interactive maps and downloadable charts
- spine chart showing multiple indicators for each area compared with benchmarks
